**Subject: Regarding Youth Parliament on LiFE (Lifestyle for Environment) Stage I**

It is to inform you that The Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change is organising Youth Parliament on LiFE which is a platform for young people to discuss and debate on various environmental aspects and come up with solutions to promote sustainable living. In addition, the event also aims to promote leadership, critical thinking, and teamwork skills among young people. The overarching theme of the Youth Parliament will be 'Individual behaviour and habits have an impact on environment and climate change'.

The Youth Parliament on LiFE is open to university and other institution students from all over India who are between the ages of 18 and 25 and enrolled in a university or institution recognized by UGC/AICTE.

The event will be organized at two levels: Stage I and Stage II. The Stage I event will be conducted through a virtual debate competition/group discussion at the university level in each state/UT and will shortlist candidates as required against that state/UT. The stage II event will be conducted by IIFM in Delhi among the shortlisted candidates from each state/UT. The shortlisted candidates will compete in a mock parliamentary debate in Delhi, and about 150 of them will be selected to be MEYPs (Members of Environment Youth Parliament). Five students will be selected after Stage II and will be given the 'Youth Icon Award' on 5th June 2023 on World Environment Day.

In view of above this department is organising the Stage I of the event and selected Panjab University, Chandigarh to invite participation. The detailed instructions of the Stage I event are as under:


- The age of participants shall be in b/w 18 and 25 and must be enrolled in a university or Institutions recognized by UGC/AICTE.

- From UT only two candidates will select for stage II which will be organised by IIFM at New Delhi.



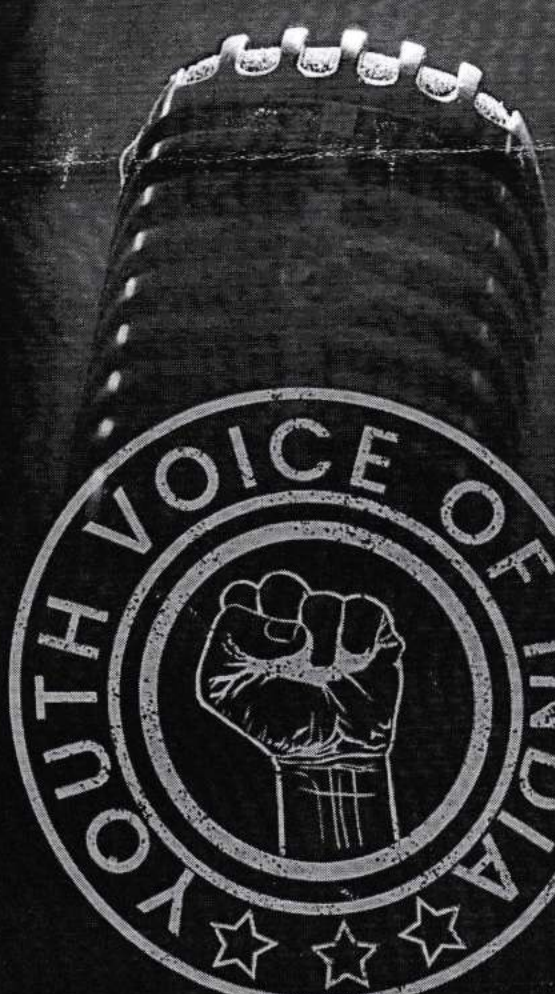

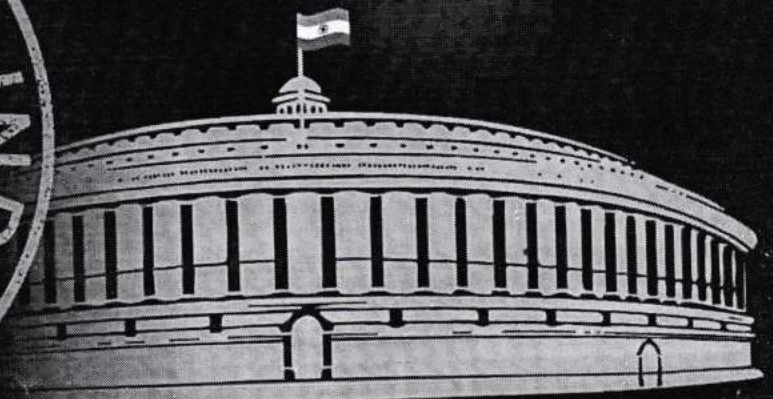
